Flu vaccinations Please ring for an appointment in one of our special flu clinics which will be commencing at the beginning of October. Flu vaccination is recommended and is free under the NHS to all people of 65 years and over, and to those of any age with a long term medical condition, for example diabetes, heart disease, kidney or liver disease, asthma or any breathing disorder. It is also recommended for pregnant women and carers. Please enquire if unsure whether you are eligible. Keep Warm Keep Well The Public Health Team at NHS Cambridgeshire and the District Council will be providing winter warmth information packs this winter. These will be available either from reception or at our flu clinics. The packs will include advice on energy assistance grants for home insulation, how to prepare homes ready for winter and how to take care during periods of low temperatures. Remember to ask for your pack.
